GAS STRUT REPLACEMENT



ULTIMATE IN-SERVICE INFORMATION

REMOVE THE OLD GAS STRUT

- 1. These tasks will require 3 people!
- 2. Have **Person 1** stand on the Bumper Bar and open the camper, while **Person 2** stabilises the lid using the Lifting Pole.
- 3. Open the Lid to the position where the Gas Strut is at its maximum extension as shown.
- 4. Have **Person 3** use a screw-driver to remove the Spring Clip on the lower end of the Gas Strut, then stand on a step-ladder to remove the clip on the upper end of the Gas Strut and prise the strut off the ball-fitting. (Place protective material between the screw-driver and the fibreglass.)
- 5. Remove the lower end of the Gas Strut from the body.

■ FIT THE NEW GAS STRUT

- 1. Ensure the end fittings on the replacement Gas Strut are fully screwed in.
- 2. Fit the thin end of the Gas Strut to the camper-body ball-fitting and replace the Spring Clip.
- 3. Hold the Gas Strut up to the ball-fitting on the lid, and have **Person 2** gently move the lid back and forth to find the point of maximum extension.
- 4. Have **Person 3** fit the thicker end of the Gas Strut to the ball-fitting on the lid using a rubber mallet to simultaneously compress the strut and engage the fittings together. Replace the Spring Clip.
- 5. Have **Persons 1 & 2** move the lid through its full range of travel to ensure there's no over-extension of the strut. (The strut should move freely and quietly throughout its entire stroke.)
